




#### Global landscape in agriculture industry


- \* Agriculture is accounting for **4%** of global gross domestic product (GDP) and more than **25%** of GDP in some least developing countries.
- Agricultural development is one of the most powerful tools to end extreme poverty, boost shared prosperity, and feed a projected 9.7 billion people by 2050.

  - Protecting the environment








World Agriculture map










Water stress optimistic Y2030

Egypt 4%







Agriculture land %



<u>Green Free Industrial Zone</u> with dependence on Solar, Wind and Hydropower, giving it a unique edge over other free zones in Georgia.


